Amber A. Hewitt, PhD

Dr. Hewitt is an American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) Science and Technology Policy Fellow at the NIH, National Institute of Mental Health. She recently completed an APA Congressional Fellowship in the Office of U.S. Senator Cory A. Booker where she staffed the Senator on health care reform and codrafted health policy legislation.
