
## Training Psychologists as Social Justice Advocates



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# What is social justice in counseling psychology?

"Actively working to change social institutions, political and economic systems, and government structures that perpetuate unfair practices, structures, and policies in terms of accessibility, resource distribution, and human rights." (Fouad, Gerstein, & Toporek, 2006)

Oriented Toward Social Justice	Demonstrates awareness of social, political, economic and cultural factors that impact individuals, institutions and systems, in addition to other factors that may lead them to seek intervention	Uses awareness of the social, political, economic or cultural factors that may impact human development in the context of service provision	Intervenes with client to promote action on factors impacting development and functioning	
Systems Change	Understands the differences between individual and institutional level interventions and system's level change	Promotes change to enhance the functioning of individuals	Promotes change at the level of institutions, community, or society	


## How do counseling psychology doctoral trainees perceive SJ training?




